(537 Franklin Avenue - next to former Ciccolini's Building)

## What should you shred?

- Bank statements that are at least one year old and do not contain tax-related information
- Pay stubs (only after you receive your W-2)
- Credit card applications
- Any other documents that contain your Social Security Number, account numbers, password/PIN information, your birth date, private contact information, and signature

## Please Note:

- Items may contain paper clips and staples.
- The process can be seen on-site via closed-circuit video.
- A limit may be placed on how much may be shredded per household.

*If you already shred at home, place that paper in **clear plastic bags** and place curbside on your recycling day to be collected by the Department of Public Works.*
